Second, we're also embracing a new name that reflects who we are, where we've been, and where we believe God is leading us:

Why "Chapel"? Because chapels are intimate spaces where we go to meet with God—quiet, sacred places that invite reflection, worship, and connection.

The name also reflects our location: we're the only church in Double Oak, right on Chinn Chapel—deeply rooted in this community we love.

There's more to share about how these changes capture our identity, call us into the next chapter of our church together, and give us a vision for the future—and I look forward to unpacking it with you in the coming weeks and months.
